- Cotford St Luke School helps children set themselves ambitious goals that provide intrinsic motivation to succeed. Children are supported to understand that achievement is based on habits and small steps of progress and that finding things difficult is a key driver of success.

The School's ethos is framed around its core values of: Appreciate, Believe and Challenge as outlined on the previous page. The school wishes to offer the best learning opportunity to its children and the school recognises the value in strong working relationships with parents and carers.

The school will provide teaching and learning that delivers the national curriculum. Support for regular attendance, a clear pathway of pastoral support, high quality reading books to be sent home, an incremental and age appropriate approach towards home learning, a consistent approach towards behaviour management based on the key tenants of:

- show kindness and respect
- make good choices to keep safe
- be ready to learn.

In the autumn and spring terms we will offer parent meetings and produce an end of year report in the summer term. The school shares information through the parentmail platform.

The school asks its parent/cares to:

- Support the school to promote the values of the school to their children.
- Read at least three times a week with their children for at least 20 minutes
- Support children to complete their homelearning.
- Help the children conform to the behaviour policy
- Help comply with uniform policy as outlined in the prospectus
- To promote regular and positive attendance (the school has a target of at least 96% attendance)
- To communicate any issues promptly with the school to help resolve them swiftly
